Primary Election - Tuesday, June 7th

Vote by Mail or Ballot Box

Mail-in ballots may be cast before 8 p.m. on June 7 through the US Post Office, at any of the 17 drop box locations throughout the County, or by visiting the Board of Elections at 20 Grove Street in Somerville, NJ.



A Drop Box is located at the front entrance to the Hillsborough Municipal Building.

Early Voting June 3rd, 4th & 5th

In-person voting early voting will take place at six locations throughout Somerset County, including the **Hillsborough Municipal Building**. Eligible voters who have not requested a mail-in ballot may cast their vote during this period.



- **Friday, June 3rd from 10 am to 8 pm**
- **Saturday, June 4th from 10 am to 8 pm**
- **Sunday, June 5th from 10 am to 6 pm**

In Person Voting on Primary Election Day

As a result of the 2020 Census, Hillsborough Township has been split into 2 Congressional Districts and has added 2 new voting districts. **You may have a new voting district!** Before you head out the door to vote on Primary Election Day, be sure to check your sample ballot to double-check your voting district and polling location.

Find Your Polling Location

1. Go to voter.svrs.nj.gov/polling-place-search or scan the QR code with the camera on your smartphone.
2. Enter your Address and Zip Code.

3. Check your District and Polling Location.

Are you up to date on your COVID vaccine?



Free Booster Clinic

June 2 and 16 from 4-7 PM

Boosters (Pfizer and Moderna) will be available for ages 5 and up:

- If you got your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna at least 5 months ago
- If you got your J&J vaccine at least 2 months ago

2nd booster

- If you are 50 or older, and got your 1st booster at least 4 months ago

The vaccine is free, but please bring your:

- Vaccine card (for the booster)
- Insurance card (if you have one)
- Medicare card (if you have one)

La vacuna es gratis, pero por favor traiga:

- Su tarjeta de vacunación (para la vacuna de refuerzo/tercera o cuarta dosis)
- Su tarjeta de seguro médico (si tiene)
- Su tarjeta de Medicare (si tiene)
