



Department Updates

Building

Construction season is upon us! Make sure to obtain all prior approvals before submitting permit applications to the Building Department. Once you receive your Construction Permit, it is important to get all of your Inspections. Permits will remain open until all Final Inspections have passed. This is important to remember, especially when selling your home!

Clerk

The County Clerk reminds voters that they can apply for a mail-in ballot for the June 4 primary election. In addition to regular weekday hours of 8:15 a.m. to 4 p.m., the County Clerk's office will have extended hours to accommodate those who want to pick up a ballot in person. Engineering

The left turn lane modification to the Triangle/Auten Road traffic signal is underway. The new poles and heads were installed recently and the wiring and electrical connections are being worked on at this time.

Once the wiring is completed and the poles and heads are aligned properly the new signal will be operational and the old poles removed. The rainy weather is not cooperating but if all goes right the new signal should be operational by next week.

Free Skin Cancer Screenings In addition, Dr. Robert llowite of the Dermatology Center in Hillsborough will provide skin cancer screenings from 8 am to 11 am during the fair. Skin cancer is the most common type of cancer, and early detection can lead to effective treatment. To register, please call the Health Department at 908-369-5652. You will need to provide your name, address, and phone number, and whether you would like only a specific mole or mark checked, or if you would like an upper body, lower body, or whole body check. If you have any questions or concerns, please call the Health Department.

Measles Update

Over 800 people in 23 states have been affected by measles this year. Most of those cases have been in the New York metro area, in very close proximity to Hillsborough. In order to prevent the spread of measles, and to protect our vulnerable population, anyone who is exposed to measles may be quarantined for several weeks if they do not have proof of vaccination or immunity.

Please be ready. Have your vaccination records handy. If you don't know whether or not you were vaccinated, or if you have immunity from having the disease, please talk to your doctor about getting vaccinated, boostered, or having a blood test to prove immunity. The vaccination

has been studied thoroughly for many years, and it is over 90% effective (2 vaccines are 97% effective). Please help to protect yourself and your community. Be ready.

OEM

Flood water and Flash Floods - Reminder to residents - Turn Around - Don't Drown

Remember:

- · DO NOT drive onto a flooded roadway
- · DO NOT go around barriers
- DO NOT drive through flowing water. If you approach a roadway
 that is flooded, TURN AROUND DON'T DROWN. It takes just
 12 inches of rushing water to carry away a small car, while 2 feet
 of rushing water can carry away most vehicles. It is NEVER safe
 to drive or walk into flood waters.
- Drive with extreme caution if roads are even just wet or it is raining. You can lose control of your vehicle if hydroplaning occurs, which is when a layer of water builds up between your tires and the road, causing there to be no direct contact between your vehicle and the road.
