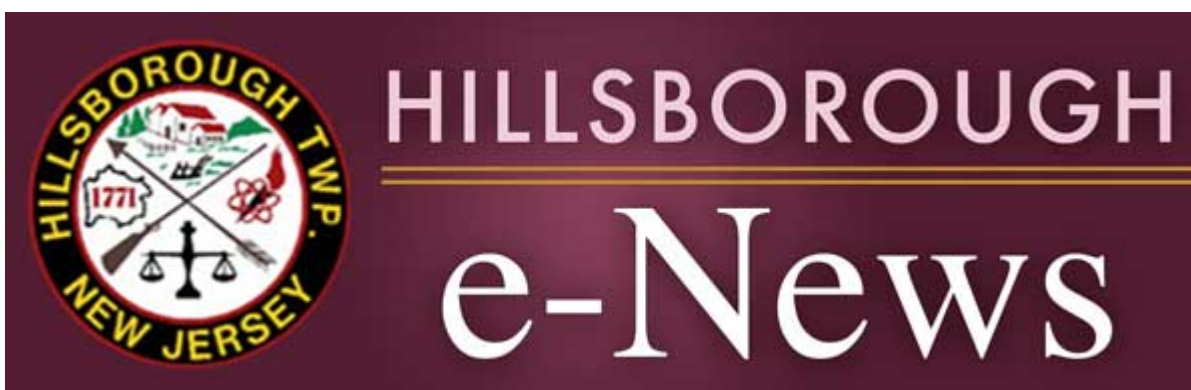

Code Ninjas Grand Opening

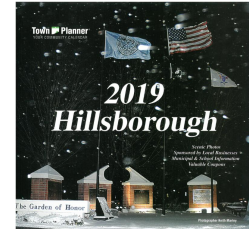

Somerset County Business Partnership. There were games, prizes, special guests, and a robotics demonstration from Hillsborough FIRST Team 75 RoboRaiders.



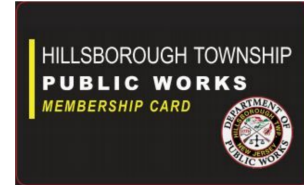
LAST CALL! Township Collecting Scenic Photos for the "2020 Hillsborough Calendar"
