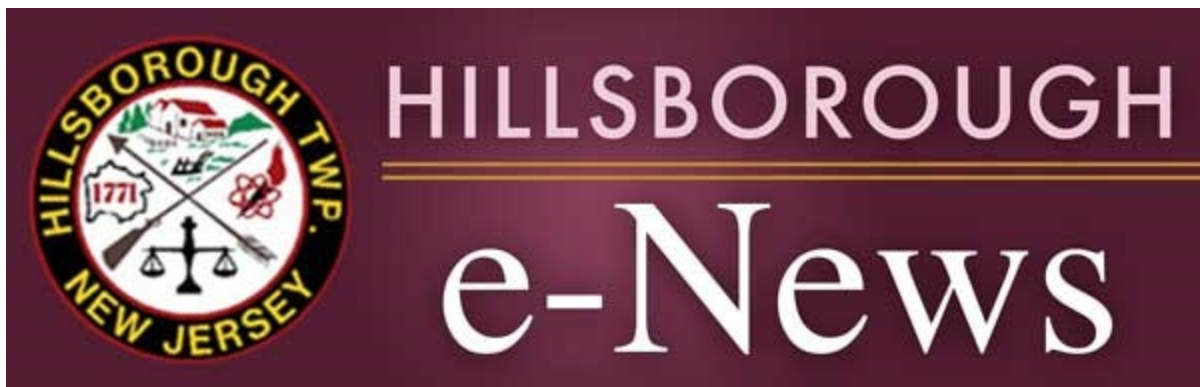

On October 26th, the Hillsborough Bocce Ball Club held their last playoff games of the season at AVM Park.

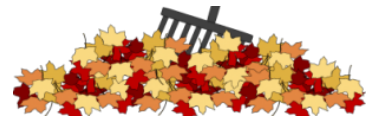

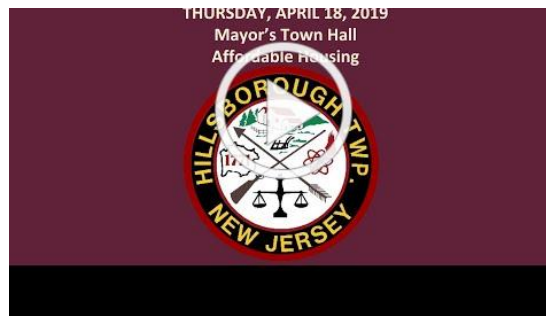

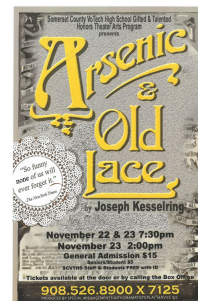
