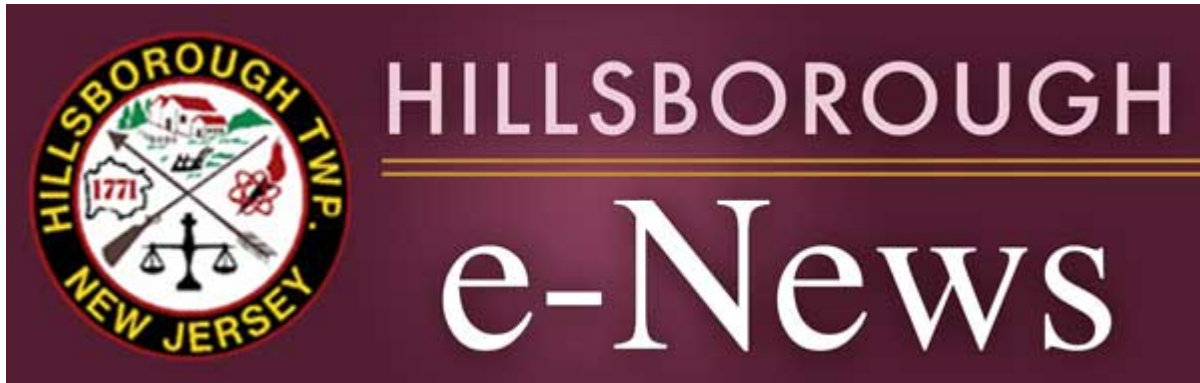




## Hillsborough-Millstone Municipal Alliance Presents: Steered Straight with Michael DeLeon

## Department Updates

### **Building Department**

Another reminder from the Building Department to residents and business owners of the amnesty program, running until January 31, 2019. The end of the month is fast approaching! This program will excuse residents and business owners from getting penalized for having open permits, having previous work done without permits, failing to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy, and/or having an expired Temporary Certificate of Occupancy. If you visit the Building Department within this allotted time frame, we will assist you with gaining compliance for your projects. Permit fees will still be applicable but, again, you will not be penalized for noncompliance.

### **Business Advocate**

### **Engineering**

Did you know that there are 530 lane miles of roadways and 115 miles of sidewalks that are maintained by Hillsborough Township? To put that into perspective the amount of infrastructure is the same distance as a trip from NJ to South Carolina!

## Health Department

### *Radon Kits*

January is Radon Awareness Month - free Radon Test Kits are still available. The local health departments in Somerset County (Greater Somerset Public Health Partnership) have agreed to designate January as Radon Action Month. Radon is a colorless, odorless gas that can be emitted from naturally occurring rocks and soil that contain uranium and radon. The Hillsborough Health Department will continue to distribute free radon test kits to Hillsborough Township residents on a first come, first served basis. Residents can call the Health Department at 908-369-5652 or stop in the Health Department between 8:30 am and 4:00 pm to get a kit. Please see further information on the health website.



### *Free Rabies Vaccination Clinic*

Annual Free Rabies Vaccination Clinic to be held on Saturday, January 26th at the Hillsborough Township Department of Public Works Yard located at 21 East Mountain Road. No pre-registration is necessary. Dogs must be leashed and cats are required to be in a secure carrier.

## OEM

*Hillsborough residents, please check your mailboxes for reflective street numbers.*

**Hillsborough residents, please check your mailboxes for reflective street numbers.** Township Ordinance requires that the house number be visible on the actual house. However, with some houses being set back far from the road in an effort for emergency responders to be able to determine proper addresses when responding, residents are encouraged to have reflective numbers on both sides of their mailboxes so that the house number is visible in both directions of the roadway.

## Police

Residents are reminded to protect themselves from becoming a victim of personal property theft in their vehicles. Keep your vehicles locked at all times and remove valuables, but if you must leave a purse or other valuables in your vehicle, at least lock them in your trunk where they are out of sight. It is better not to leave valuables in your car.
