<u>Mayor DelCore Announces Infrastructure Improvements</u>

2019 Road Paving Schedule

"Hillsborough Township is moving forward with the 2019 road paving plan as stated late last year when the Township bonded \$8.5 M," announced Mayor Frank DelCore.

"Aging infrastructure further compromised by severe weather, freeze and thaw have taken their toll on our infrastructure and resulted in the issuance of bonds to fund this major paving initiative. The Township maintains a 5-year roadway plan, with 14 roadways, totaling over 20 miles, having already been repaved," added Mayor Frank DelCore.

The following roadways are slated for the 2019 paving program:

- Willow Road, Phase 1 (between Amwell Road and Valinor Drive)
- Euclid Avenue
- Riverside Drive (between River Road and Clawson Avenue)
- Clawson Avenue
- Wertsville Road (between Long Hill Road and Montgomery Road)
- Raider Boulevard (between Route 206 and Stryker Lane)
- South Triangle Road
- Cardinal Lane
- Wescott Road (between South Branch Road and Amwell Road)

Department Updates

Building Department

If you are experiencing electrical problems in your home, make sure to call a Licensed Electrician to take a look. A qualified individual assessing the issue, and receiving the necessary Electrical Inspections from the Building Department can help ensure the proper safety of installation or repairs. According to the Nation Fire Protection

Association, between 2010-2014 there were 45,210 reported fires involving electrical malfunctions.

Engineering

Health Department

The Health Department reminds us that March is Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month. Colorectal Cancer is cancer of the large intestine (colon) and rectum. It is the second most deadly cancer of men and women behind lung cancer. Colorectal cancer can develop over time and with early detection can be cured. When abnormal growths called polyps are removed early enough, they will not develop into invasive cancer.

Although some people can get colorectal cancer at a younger age, a risk factor for this cancer is being over age 50. Therefore, the American Cancer Society recommends that all men and women age 50 and over get screened for colorectal cancer. Heredity can also put you at risk, so if someone in your family developed this cancer, you may be at a higher risk. Other predisposing risk factors can be found in the online links found in the Health Department website under "disease prevention".

For those on Medicaid or without medical insurance, the Zufall Health Center, a Federally Qualified Health Center, located at 71 4th Street in Somerville offers cancer screening tests for reduced cost or free. Their phone number is 908-526-2335.
