




Residents are reminded to protect themselves from becoming a victim of personal property and identity theft in their vehicles

[Somerset County Parks Commission To Recycle Natural Christmas Trees](#)

The Somerset County Park Commission will be accepting natural Christmas trees for recycling from Thursday, December 26, 2019 through Friday, January 31, 2020. Each family is limited to only one tree that must be free of all ornaments, wires, netting, and tinsel. Only natural trees will be accepted. Wreaths and garland will not be accepted as these items cannot be recycled. Deliveries from groups or dealers will be rejected. Following these guidelines is necessary to maintain a manageable recycling program.
