Department Updates

Municipal Building Now Open

After several months of the Peter J. Biondi Municipal Building being closed to the public amid the COVID-19 public health crisis, the building has reopened. The hours of operation for the building will be Monday - Friday, 8 am until 4:30 pm until further notice.

Safety precautions are in place to protect both the public and the employees of the facility. Visitors are required to wear a mask or other facial covering and are reminded to practice social distancing of at least 6 feet apart. Visitors to the building for any purpose will be required to sign in the Visitor Entry Log, located at the main entrance of the building.

If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms or have experienced these symptoms in the last 72 hours, please do not enter this building:

- Have a fever or feel feverish
- Cough (unrelated to allergies)
- Shortness of breath
- · Unusual fatigue
- New loss of sense of taste or smell
- Worsening / consistent headaches
- Unusual muscle pain
- Sore throat (unrelated to allergies)
- Diarrhea
- Nausea
- Vomiting

Visitors are reminded that all services are available <u>online</u> or by calling the respective departments. Although we miss having our residents and visitors in the building, we are asking your help in preventing the spread of COVID-19 and adhering to the above requirements.
