Auten Road Debris Facility will be Open August 14th and 15th for Storm Related Tree Debris Only


Hillsborough Township Public Works Department will open the Auten Road Debris Facility on Friday and Saturday, August 14th and 15th, from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm to allow residents to drop off tree debris from the storm. Residents must show ID at the gate. The Auten Road Debris Facility is located opposite of the Auten Road School, next to the railroad tracks.

Due to COVID-19 the following safety practices are mandatory. Those who do not adhere to these practices will be turned away at the gate.

- You MUST wear a mask and gloves at all times while at our facility
- You MUST adhere to social distancing
- You MUST NOT exit your vehicle until you are informed to do so

A Message from the Building Department


The building is open to the public but should you not want to come inside, the Building Department is still accepting credit card payments over the phone. We can also guide you with all of your permitting needs over the phone. All of our permit applications and handouts are available on the Township website under the [Building Department section](#).

Right-Of-Way Information from the Engineering Department

The area of land along the road frontage of most properties is considered “right-of-way” or R.O.W. This area varies in width depending on the road and its pavement width. The R.O.W. gives rights to the Township and utility companies to place sidewalk and electric, gas, telephone, cable, and other utilities within this area. The right-of-way can also be used for road widening. The R.O.W. area must be maintained by the property owner per Township Ordinance. Property owners are not allowed to install fences and other obstructions within the right-of-way area. Mailboxes are permitted as long as they are break-away. You can contact the [Engineering Office](#) for any questions about right-of-way areas.



