


Approximately a third of the parking lot will be under construction, so most of the lot will still be available for parking use. Plans are available in the Engineering Office showing the new layout.

The State of New Jersey has not released the Homestead Credits yet and therefore you will not see that adjustment on this billing. If the State does release the credits, you will receive an adjusted bill for the 4th quarter at that time.

Police

Old prescription medications can be dropped in the Hillsborough Police Department Medicine Drop Box located in the Police Lobby. The drop box is only available Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8 am to 4:30 pm. Residents will have to sign in as they enter the police lobby before they can access the drop box.

If there is other Municipal business that residents need to conduct after dropping off their old prescription medications, they will need to re-enter the building through the front door and sign-in at the Receptionist Desk.





