COVID-19 Vaccine Update

To register for the COVID Vaccine: please visit the NJ State Website at https://covidvaccine.nj.gov/. This is for individuals who qualify. Presently, qualified individuals are those who are over the age of 65 and those individuals between the ages of 16 and 64 with chronic health conditions.



Once you register, please be patient. You will receive an email.

This site aslo has information regarding other clinics in the state. There are now some CVS and Rite Aid Stores, along with ShopRites, and the RWJBarnabas Hospital in Somerville that are giving vaccinations. Supplies may be low, and some sites may not be making appointments until they receive more supplies of vaccine, so keep checking the websites of the other clinics and register there as well.
