The ordinance, which will be discussed at a public hearing on May 25th, prohibits cannabis establishments, delivery services and distributors from operating anywhere within the Township of Hillsborough, except for the delivery of cannabis and related supplies by a delivery service.


Hillsborough Township Partners with Rotary Club to Collect Book Donations

All residents, businesses, community groups, classrooms, clubs and organizations are invited and encouraged to participate. Registration closes May 15th.





On Monday, April 19th, vaccine eligibility expanded to include all individuals 16 and older who live, work, or study in New Jersey.



As of this week:

- More than 5.8 million vaccine doses have been administered in New Jersey
- More than 3.6 million people have received at least one dose
- More than 2.3 million people are fully vaccinated
