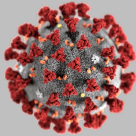

At the July 13th Township Committee meeting, Deputy Mayor Del Core presented Jack Macias with a proclamation recognizing him for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.

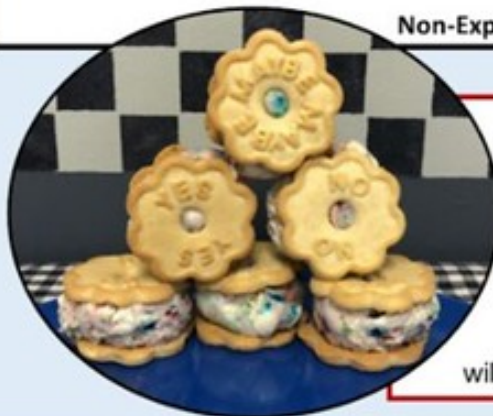
