
Municipal Offices Closed Friday

Senior Curbside Pickup Reminders

Please be advised that all senior curbside pick items must follow the following guidelines or they will not be accepted: Ten (10) Items Maximum (Boxed or Bundled Items Count as One) can be put out, with a manageable amount of brush. Branches can not be more than 6' in length and the cut ends should be facing the curb. The pile should not be larger than 15' long x 5' high x 6' wide. Please see the photos above for reference. There is no cost for this program.


