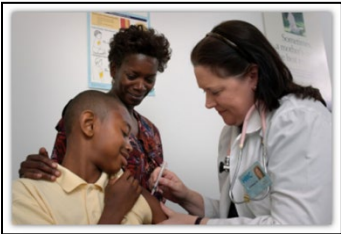




## The Importance of Immunizing your Child

In conjunction with local Health Departments, Community VNA holds monthly Child Health Conferences free for uninsured children. These **well-child visits are essential for many reasons**, including:

- Tracking growth and development including milestones, social behaviors, and learning
- Discussing any concerns about your child's health
- Getting scheduled vaccinations in compliance with NJ State Immunization Requirements

**COVID Safety:** All Child Health Clinic sites have been cleaned and sanitized. Clinic staff has been trained in appropriate PPE (Personal Protection Equipment). Clinics have developed strict screening protocols, safe scheduling times and cleaning before and after each appointment to assure your safety.
