



Bentley Community Services Helps Families, Seniors and Individuals Regain Self-Sufficiency

For eight years, Bentley Community Services (BCS) a designated 501 (c) 3 charitable organization, has been helping families, seniors and individuals in financial crisis regain self-sufficiency by providing a full range of high quality grocery provisions and more each week, offsetting/eliminating weekly grocery bills. Bentley has distributed over 1.8 million lbs. of high quality foods to date and helped 114 families regain self-sufficiency. Numerous families from Hillsborough have received help and presently are clients. BCS creates access to and provides healthy foods, facilitating healthy diets and nutrition so families benefit weekly from full shopping carts, feeding their families healthy and nutritious foods from the major food groups, offsetting/eliminating weekly grocery bills. The crucial monies that families save they then have toward paying their monthly bills and expenses, reducing and paying off debts, medical bills and copays as they get on the fast track toward financial stability and security. Bentley also offers educational and informational workshops throughout the year facilitated by professionals.

BCS operated for two years and then outgrew its origins in Belle Mead and is located in the Monmouth Junction portion of South Brunswick where it serves clientele families that come from Somerset County and also the entire Central New Jersey region of communities. They typically do not receive assistance so Bentley is a vital community connection for them to receive help. Clientele receive weekly fresh vegetables and fruits, dairy products, high quality breads/desserts, salads, meats, poultry, seafood, numerous fresh and frozen products, non-perishables, toiletries and household provisions.

BCS is an alternative food bank/pantry servicing the entire Central New Jersey region of communities, specifically addressing the needs of families, seniors and individuals who, though perhaps employed, do not receive traditional assistances and are challenged making ends meet. If you are struggling to make ends meets or know of a family who is, please refer them to BCS. We are currently accepting applications. There are also volunteer opportunities available.
