

There will be six leaf clean-up crews throughout Hillsborough Township for the week of December 6th through the 11th. (Monday through Saturday)

- A crew in the Flanders area, Royce Brook Development, Piney Woods/Steimeitz areas, and Meadowbrook area.
- A crew in the Kilmer Drive area, Michelle Lane and Walnut Grove areas, Scott Drive area, and Joshua Drive area.
- A crew in the Amsterdam Drive area, Riverview Terrace area, Steeple Chase area, South Woods Road area, and Woodmere area.
- A crew in the Polhemus Drive area, Rine/Wallace/Sweeny areas, Woodfield Estates area, Sunrise area, and Atkinson Circle.
- A crew on Amwell Road, Mill Lane Road, South Branch Road, Old Village Road, the Chamberlain area, Carrol/Crater area, and Orchard Drive.
- A crew in the Green Hills area, Dickerson area, Brooks Boulevard area, Partridge area, Valley Road area, and the Banor Drive area.



This schedule is dependent on weather, manpower, equipment breakage, and other unforeseen issues. If you don't see your street on the list, please be patient. A crew will be in your area as soon as possible.

Please note: Residents can take leaves to the Auten Road site the first three Saturdays in December, this is for grass and leaves ONLY. The Auten Road Site does not accept brush or bulk items at these events. The Auten Road Site is also open on the third Friday of each month between 11 am - 3 pm for Grass and Leaf Drop off ONLY.



initiative. If you sponsored a flag and would like to keep the tag that was attached, you can pick yours up in the Clerk's Office during regular business hours.




Shopping for the Holidays?
