Led by head coach Kevin Carty, and coaches Don Adams, Justin Balunsat, Wayne Briggs, Kevin Carty, Sr., Chris Ciccone, PJ Jankowicz, Rocco Mazzagatti, Brandon Wiater, and trainers Amanda Miller and Michael Shiffman, the Hillsborough High School Varsity Football Team achieved the title of NJSIAA South Group V Regional Champions after their 28 to 7 win over Kingsway Regional High School.

Coach Kevin Carty: Courier News Coach of the Year

Coach Carty graduated from Somerville High School where he led the Pioneers to a state sectional championship in 1994 playing for his father, Coach Kevin Carty Sr. Kevin Carty went on to play at the University of North Carolina and William and Mary College before coaching football at Somerville High School, Patterson-Kennedy, and Bound Brook High Schools before coaching at Hillsborough High School.

Coach Carty has led the Hillsborough High School Football Team for 11 seasons and earned his 100th career coaching victory in the Regional Championship win over Kingsway. He also has an overall record of 66-46 and the team has advanced to the playoffs in all but two seasons during his tenure.

• A crew in the Beverly Drive area, Camden Area, White Meadow Road area,


- Willow Road area, Willows Edge area, Valinor Road area, Tally Ho Trail area, and Fox Chase Run area.

- A crew in Partridge Road area, Valley Road area, Camplain Road area, Sunnymead Road area, Weston Road area, North Willow Road area, and Millstone River Road area.
- A crew on South Branch Road, Old Village Road, the Chamberlain Drive area, Carrol/Crater area, and on Orchard Drive, South Branch River Road, New Centre Road, Beekman Lane, and East Mountain Road.
- A crew in the Banor Drive area, on Triangle Road, in the Stockton Road area, Crestmont Drive area, Wyckoff Way area, Perrine Pike area, Rivendell Road area, Yates Drive area, Van Zandt Drive area, and the Independence Drive area.
