Township Committee Honors 3 Eagle Scouts

Evan's Eagle Scout project consisted of planning, fundraising, designing and building five Patrol Boxes for Camp Agnes DeWitt. The project was completed in 204 hours with the assistance of 10 scouts, 4 leaders, 6 adults and friends. The rectangular boxes have removable shelves and a latch to keep the box secure. These boxes allow supplies

to be stored safely and securely from weather and wildlife. The impact of the project provides a means of keeping the campgrounds neat, safe and secure.

Jonathan's Eagle Scout project consisted of planning, fundraising, organizing, building and staining three sturdy benches around a campfire pit for St. Joseph's Parish. The project took 147 hours to complete with the help of 12 scouts and 13 adult leaders. The completed project provides a comfortable seating area that benefits the youth ministry as well as other church groups using the fire pit.

Alexander Mindish

Alexander's Eagle Scout project consisted of planning, fundraising, and building a pedestrian bridge at the Sourland Mountains Preserve benefitting Somerset Parks and Recreation as well as local hikers and mountain bikers. He built the bridge with the help of 5 leaders and 8 scouts over 94.5 hours. Today bikers and hikers can travel the path without having to traverse a flooded ravine.

<u>Engineering</u>	The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has snow removal guidelines. It is recommended that residents and businesses avoid piling up snow in front of storm sewer catch basins. This will cause flooding when melting occurs, but the piled snow may contain sand, sediment and other debris which can impact the brooks and streams. Please pile snow as far away from storm sewer catch basins as possible.
<u>Finance</u> <u>Department</u>	Tax Assessment Cards have been mailed. If you need additional information about taxes paid or would like a recap of the property taxes paid in 2018, please contact the Finance/Tax Collector's Office and they will be happy to mail or email you the information.
<u>Health Department</u>	The Health Department has distributed 161 free radon test kits since the start of the program in 2018. There are a few kits still available. Please come in to the Health Department Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:00 pm to pick up a kit. The first Blood Pressure Clinic was offered on Thursday, February 21st. Another one will be offered on March 21st from 11:30 am until 12:30 pm for all Hillsborough adults age 18 and over. High Blood Pressure is the Silent Killer. The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness offers valuable information regarding emerging threats and suspicious activity reporting tips. Members of the Hillsborough Police Department took the plunge into the frigid Atlantic Ocean with over 7,000 of their brave friends, while approximately 50,000 spectators stayed warm. This year's event raised a record \$2.3M, which blew past the plunge's \$2M goal. Each year, the Polar Bear Plunge in Seaside hosts the fundraising event for Special Olympics New Jersey. 
