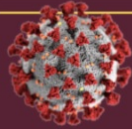

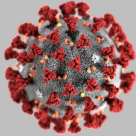

Covid Connect Helpline for Mental Health and Substance Abuse Issues

Rutgers University Behavioral Health Care (RUBHC) has just announced the Covid Connect Helpline (833) 223-0011. This new FREE helpline will provide and expand behavioral health treatments and support to individuals who are experiencing mental health and substance abuse issues related to the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

A series of screening tools will be used to assess the caller's level of distress and mental health/addiction needs. University Behavioral Health Care will provide a warm handoff to licensed treatment providers throughout the state that offer Telehealth services. To ensure successful service linkage, our staff will follow up with all callers. The hotline is available Monday through Friday, 8am to 8pm.

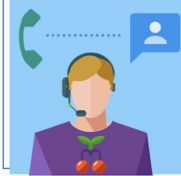
