On January 21st, Mayor Shawn Lipani attended the ribbon-cutting for the opening of Somerset County's first distillery.

Bellemara is currently distilling "grain to glass" single malt gin and single malt spirit. All equipment used on-site in the distillery process was specially designed and made for Bellemara, including two copper pot stills made in and shipped from Italy.

## Somerset County Update: Rock Brook Bridge

Construction on the Rock Brook Bridge near Longhill / Wertsville Roads is on hold because during Tropical Storm Ida, there was substantial damage to the bridge while it was under construction. The damage



requires a major change in the scope of work on the bridge and DEP requires updated permits. The County is redoing the plans and submitting to DEP for re-approval. The County anticipates the plans will be completed and re-approved in the next month or so. There is a lot of concrete and stonework at this bridge and they do not see construction starting up until the spring due to cold weather.




