Road Closure: River Road at Elm Street

(CR567) River Road in Hillsborough will be closed for approximately 10 weeks beginning on Monday 5/2/2022. Norfolk Southern will be working on Bridge repairs and will have ongoing construction occurring at the train bridge on River Road by Elm Street. The work zone is approximately 700' beginning 100' North of Elm Street. The road will be closed



for the entire duration of construction and there will be a posted detour in effect at Amwell Road and Opie Road.

Prescription Drug Take Back Day**

Drug overdoses and drug overdose-related deaths are up over last year, with 3,124 drug overdose deaths reported in New Jersey in 2021. A majority of these deaths involved some form of an opioid. As the Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is on April 30th, residents should take stock of their medicine cabinets and safely dispose of any unused or expired medication.

Boosters (Pfizer and Moderna) will be available for ages 12 and up:

- If you got your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna at least 5 months ago
- If you got your J&J vaccine at least 2 months ago

2nd booster:

- If you are 50 or older, and got your 1st booster at least 4 months ago

Pfizer vaccine for kids 5-11 will also be available.

The vaccine is free, but please bring your:

- Vaccine card (for the booster)
- Insurance card (if you have one)
- Medicare card (if you have one)

Hillsborough, NJ, beginning with an 11:00 AM registration, and 1:00 PM shotgun start, followed by a 6 PM dinner. 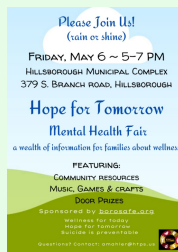
