Located at the Municipal Complex, the charging station was installed thanks to a grant, "It Pay\$ to Plug-In Electric Vehicle Charging Grants Program", that was awarded to the township in the amount of \$8,000.

Completed applications must be submitted to the Administration Office by Friday, September 30th.




Pictured: Hillsborough Rockettes and Rocket receive a grant funded by the Hillsborough Rewards Credit Card Program.




