- Never pass a stopped school bus when lights are flashing and

 - Be aware of increased pedestrian traffic as children and their
 parents walk back and forth to school.
- If on the opposite side of a median as a stopped bus, reduce speed to 10 mph.
- Allow for extra travel time and anticipate increased volume around school facilities.



The NJ Poison Control Center provides information and medical treatment advice to people of all ages for potentially dangerous exposures to common summer hazards — alcohol, plants, sunburn, wild mushrooms, bites and stings, insect spray, carbon monoxide, and food poisoning.
